Vidisept N Ophtiole

Polyvinyl pyrrolidone Cetrimonium chloride

The standard preparation to the Dry-eye

Composition: 1ml contains Polyvinyl pyrrolidone (Polyvidone) 50.0mg, preserved with Cetrimonium chloride 0.04mg.

Properties: Vidisept Ophtiole is a mild non-astringent disinfectant for the eyes without influence on vessels. Cetrimonium chloride exercises a bacteriostatic and fungistatic effect. Due to the inclusion of Povidone in the formula, Vidisept Ophtiole is a non-sticky ophthalmic lubricant that provides the eye with a protective film of considerable adhesive strength, eliminates irritation caused by foreign bodies and does not impede vision. Subjectively, Vidisept is found to be free of irritation; the objective tolerance is excellent.

Contraindications: not known

Indications: Common place eye affections of all types; irritations due to dust, smoke or light; dryness of the cornea due to heat or wind; corneal erosions; keratoconjunctivitis sicca; prophylaxis of catarrhal diseases of conjunctiva; as artificial lacrymal fluid in cases of dry eye syndrome.

Dosage and application: Unless otherwise prescribed, instil when required 1-2 drops 3-5 times daily.

Side effects: not known

Presentation: Ophtiole (dropper bottle) of 5 ml.

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
